






#### 2020 Fall Membership By Subgroup: Racial and Ethnic Groups







Short-Term Suspensions: 2020-2021




#### Long-Term Suspensions

Long-Term Supensions: 2020-2021





Expulsions: 2020-2021





#### Free and Reduced Meal Eligibility: 2020-2021




## Free and Reduced Breakfast Participation of Eligible Students




